UN Alternative Care Guidelines and unaccompanied and separated children

"Unaccompanied or separated children already abroad should, in principle, enjoy the same level of protection and care as national

children in the country concerned".

EU legal framework

- UN Convention on the Rights of Child signed by all EU MS
- EU Charter on Fundamental Rights, Article 24
- Specific provisions on accommodation in Reception Conditions Directive:

Specialised facilities, priority to family type care and foster care

- In addition, specific provisions prompt on appointment of guardians to all unaccompanied children (EU asylum acquis, Antitrafficking Directive, Victim's Rights Directive)
- EU DI policy



Key challenges

- Appointment of responsible adult-guardianship
- Prioritization of foster care <u>vs</u> residential care
- Individual need assessment
- Promote safety and well being of the child
- Vetting and training requirements for care staff
- Independent oversight and complaint mechanism



Steps forward

- Integrated child protection systems
- Develop national standards on alternative care in line with the UN Alternative Care Guidelines
- Promote equity of care
- Strengthen participation of children
- (Joint) training activities
