




Key expected results

1- 3500 children safely reintegrated from residential care, good quality case management and programme support

 SOP for closure and transition of institutions to community-based care and reintegration of children
Collaboration of government and NGOs social workers for effective case management, family-preservation and broader child protection interventions
Harmonized inter-agency case management system

2- No new residential care institutions authorized to operate & No children under 3 years

Regular inspections of residential care institutions using innovative mobile technology


