

### Background

- Deinstitutionalization began in 2004 following the devastating tsunami.
- The research in 2007 revealed shocking low quality of care in institutions.
- 1) 500,000 children in 8,000 unregulated private institutions.
- 90% of these children still had one or both parents alive.
- 3) The main reasons are poverty and access to education.

**Social protection for marginalized children.** Began in 2010. Targets 150,000 children/year. USD 25million/ year.



**Family Hope Program.** Children access health and education. Piloted in 2007 and increased since 2010. Target increased to 6m of 29m poor families (2016). Total USD 6 billion.
