Strategy for National Child Care Reform

Foundation

- UNCRC (1989), AU Charter
- Rwanda Constitution (2003, revised 2015), Law N.54/2011 Related to the Rights and Protection of the Child, 2011 Integrated Child Rights Policy

Goal

- Supporting vulnerable families to remain together
- Promoting a positive Rwandan social value: families and communities to take responsibility for every child

Tubarerere mu Muryango Programme (Let's Raise Children in Families)

TMM

- Developed partnership with UNICEF, HHC, Global Communities and other CSOs
- Launched in 2013 to implement the Strategy
- Carried out by 68 professional social workers and psychologists at district level

Key Actions

- Safely reintegrating children into families
- Transforming institutions into child-centred community structures
- Providing vulnerable families with phycho-social & economic support
- Conducting regular follow up visits

Tubarerere mu Muryango Programme (Let's Raise Children in Families)

Achievement

- As of now, 2,294 out of 3,323 children living in orphanages have been placed in family based care.
- Selection of a total of 29,678 "Inshuti z'Umuryango" (Friends of the Family), community-based child protection volunteers

Challenges

- Resistance from some institution managers
- Reintegration of young adults
- Reintegration of children with disabilities
