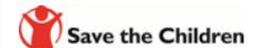

Background

- Deinstitutionalization began in 2004 following the devastating tsunami.

← The research in 2007 revealed shocking low quality of care in institutions.


- 1) 500,000 children in 8,000 unregulated private institutions.
- 2) 90% of these children still had one or both parents alive.
- 3) The main reasons are poverty and access to education.

Direct Response



Child and Family Support Center. Began in 2010 and scale up 9 districts in 4 province by 2016. <https://youtu.be/5sBHhgExsgk>



Social protection for marginalized children. Began in 2010. Targets 150,000 children/year. USD 25million/ year.



Family Hope Program. Children access health and education. Piloted in 2007 and increased since 2010. Target increased to 6m of 29m poor families (2016). Total USD 6 billion.

Direct Response



Standard of Procedures on case management and referral system (9 districts)



Trainings for social workers on permanency planning, good parenting, case management, positive discipline, child abuse, child rights, child safeguarding and supervision.



The certification body of social work established in 2011 and 485 social worker certified (2015).

Lesson learnt

De-I process in Indonesia is transformation roles of the institutions and improve alternative care system.

The focus is to improve child welfare and protection are well delivered for children and families.

Strengthening social service workforce both professional and community workers.
